St. Agnes School Parent Volunteer Hours

St. Agnes families benefit from relatively low tuition, due in large part to the support of the Parish and the fundraising efforts of the Home and School Association. We depend on the help of our school families to support us through, not only timely tuition payments, but also through volunteerism.

The time you give helps keep tuition costs down, but more importantly affords you the opportunity to build connections with fellow St. Agnes families. This is the village that will be helping you raise your child/children.

St. Agnes **requires** each family to volunteer their time to: the **St. Agnes Premiere**, which is held the 3rd Friday in November, the **Penny Carnival** the first Sunday in March and assist with the our **lunch program 6 times per school year**.

- ◆ **St. Agnes Premiere**—The St. Agnes Foundation coordinates this spectacular event. It is a formal dinner with a silent auction. Notes to volunteer for this event will be sent home in September.
- ◆ **St. Agnes Penny Carnival**—St. Agnes Home and School Association organizes this annual event, information will be sent home in the month of January/February.
- ◆ **Lunch Volunteers:** With the implementation of our own lunch program, it is necessary for each family to help with serving and clean-up at least **6** times per school year. Other family members (grandparents, aunts/uncles, etc.) or friends can fill in for a family whose work/family schedule makes it impossible for them to help in the middle of the day.
